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## Challenges

- Destruction of physical buildings, equipment, resources- sheer dollar amount to rebuild- drop in oil prices; major military campaign
- Severe, multi-generational trauma few resources to adequately deal with
- O Fractured communities
- O Destroyed livelihoods
- Need for transitional justice
- O Uncertainty surrounding Da'esh families
- General mistrust- targeting of leaders/academics
