Proposed subcommittee Why is it needed? Is the work ongoing?	The Resources and Networking Subcommittee creates and maintains resources for the Leading Internationalization Network (LIZN), in coordination with the IEL KC team and Network Leader. The work is ongoing to ensure that new materials appear regularly and that existing resources are kept up-to-date.

Subcommittee composition: Who selects chair? Number of members? Skills needed?	The chair of this Subcommittee is appointed by the IEL KC Chair. The Subcommittee consists of 5-8 members who have expertise in international education leadership along with good writing skills.
Time commitment for Members	20 to 30 hours per semester Subcommittee members are asked to serve 2-year terms.
