- In 2014 Colombia became Latin America's fastest-growing big economy


Colombia, a general context

It has the 34th strongest Higher Education System according to QS and *TopUniversities.com* released on May 18th on the **Top 50 Systems in the world**

In Latin America **Colombia** ranks **4th** (After Argentina, Brazil, Chile and México), and it is a **Rising Star** in the Region

"Economic context", it measures the impact of the investment in Higher Education has on the quality of the system. **Colombia is 19th in the world and 3rd in LatinAmerica** In the Global Competitiveness Report 2015-2016 Colombia ranks 61/140 economies, rising in the rankings for the second consecutive year



Higher Education Degrees 2014




In 2014 only 0,1%

out of 358,020 students obtained a degree in Mathematics and Natural **Sciences**







The program started with a Pilot and it was launched in January 2016 for 40 Nexo Global students

Profile: Nexo Global students

We want to provide our best students with Nexo Global experience. They need to comply with the following criteria to get the best out of the journey:

- The students must be enrolled in **Colombian accredited programs** (from private and public Universities around the country)
- The students must have finished **70%** of their credits
- The research field must be developed in STEM + Agriculture and Social
 Sciences (post conflict oriented)
- The students must have a **GPA of 3.8 or higher** (on a 0 to 5 grade scale)
- The students must certify foreign language proficiency level according to the requirement of the host University
