The Essential Packing List For Traveling While Studying Abroad

The Essential Packing List For Traveling While Studying Abroad

If you are studying abroad (or planning to), chances are that you will be doing some traveling, either within your host country or to nearby countries. As a student that typically means traveling on the cheap, probably getting there via bus (possibly by train in Europe), and staying in hostels once you arrive at your destination. During my first 3-day weekend trip in Argentina last week, I discovered that there were many things I wish I had packed that I hadn't, and others I had packed that I didn't need. Thus my "Essential Packing List" was conceived. This is purely based on my experience and preferences but I hope some of it will help you with your packing choices as well!

A Quick Note: I recommend investing in a decent backpack if you are planning on doing a lot of traveling while you are abroad. This is something I didn't do and now wish I had. If you are going to be lugging your things around for days on end, you will want it to be as pleasant and back-pain-free of an experience as possible so a good backpack will be well-worth the investment.

DO Pack:

- Enough pants/shorts to last you half of the time you will be traveling (i.e. 2 pairs for 4 days), or less
- Enough shirts, underwear and socks to last you the full time you'll be traveling, or less
- Weather-appropriate attire and if you are going somewhere with unpredictable weather like Iguazu Falls, pack for rain or shine!
- Sports bras (for girls) for the bus/train you are not going to want to spend hours and hours wearing a tight bra, trust me
- · A swimsuit if the weather will be nice; many hostels have pools
- Travel-size toiletries and only the essentials! You can also buy toiletries when you
 arrive but you might not be able to find small bottles
- A towel most hostels will allow you to use one for a small fee but they are not included like they are in hotels!
- Shower chose I was plactic flin-flone: those bootel chowers can be pretty nacty

Return to Salamanca

Twenty-three years ago I studied abroad in Salamanca, Spain. While I can say the experience was a highlight in my college career, I also firmly believe that the experience shaped my life in many different aspects. Decisions and choices I have made over the years I can often trace back to the influence of my time abroad. Sometimes there is an overt connection, such as in my appetite for traveling the world or choosing a career as a study abroad advisor at a university. And sometimes the thread connecting the study abroad experience to the life choice is very subtle and not so obvious, yet it is there. I recognize it when I am tolerant, when I am curious, when I am lonely and when I embrace new friends.

Recently my study abroad experience truly came full circle when I returned for the first time to the city I lived in as a college student more than 20 years ago. Ironically, the occasion that brought me there was study abroad-related. I was invited by a study abroad provider to do a site visit to five cities in Spain, one of which was Salamanca. In the

Cheryl Matherly was going through résumés with a hiring manager for a major consulting firm when she had her "aha" moment.

Like many employers, the campus recruiter put a premium on the ability of potential hires to succeed in unfamiliar situations with co-workers from different backgrounds and cultures. Ms. Matherly, then assistant dean of students for career and international education at Rice University, thought she had the perfect candidate, a history major who had won a scholarship to conduct three months of solo

research in Spain. The value of his having navigated working alone in a foreign country, she thought, was obvious.

But the recruiter pushed the résumé aside, dismissing the student's experience as a "backpacking trip through Europe," Ms. Matherly recalls. "That's what it boiled down to for him."

"It spoke volumes to me about how employers commonly view an overseas-study experience," she says.

The discrepancy isn't unusual. Even in an increasingly global economy, few companies set out to


How can I use foursquare for my college or university?
