

- Allowed advisers to experience the diversity of U.S.
   higher education system firsthand.
- o 1984 First group of 50 overseas advisers came to U.S.
- o 600 advisers from 128 countries have received training
- o Hundreds of campus hosts



## Local Scholarship Opportunities

- o American Chamber of Commerce Malaysia







## **Secondary School**

- Three types of institutions offer secondary school
- o Public schools (government aided)
- o Mission schools
- o Private schools
- o The MSCE is written at the end of secondary school

## **Tertiary Education**

- o Only 1500 candidates admitted into UNIMA.
- Others end at teacher training colleges and technical institutions.



  - fully research degree










#### Estonia-U.S. Higher Education Student Mobility 2001-2008
