Proof of Funds





- Depends on the school but students are typically required to show proof of funds for one year or until the date of their I-20, DS-2019
- Bank statement, employment letters
 (TA/GA letters), conditional loan approval,
 letter of support


- Merit awards (based on academic and test performance)

 - Trustee Award




Primary Sources of Funding 2010 - 2011

Assist the student in filling out necessary paperwork





Finding the Right Loan

Find a lender that works with international students

Lenders must work with a school as the loan amount has to be approved by the institution

Get approval and receive loan upon arrival

How it Works

- Apply online
- Borrow total cost of education
 - Minus any other financial aid!
- Need a US cosigner
 - US citizen or US permanent resident
 - Good credit history
 - Lived in the US past 2 years
- Initial approval within 2-6 weeks
