## WHY PARENTS WORRY SO MUCH

- Loss of control
- Fear of the unknown
- Preconceived notions/inaccuracies
- Media portrayal
- Prior experience with university bureaucracy







## WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW

- Practical reasons for studying abroad
- Payment and registration procedures
- Health, safety, and emergency procedures on program
- How/when to contact students directly
- Who to contact in an emergency
- Re-entry preparation







# INTERACTING WITH PARENTS: NEWSLETTER/EMAIL LIST/FLYER

- Does your university have a parents' newsletter?
- Monthly? Quarterly? Yearly?
- Focused on parents of future travelers?
   Current travelers? Past travelers?



# INTERACTING WITH PARENTS: WEBSITE FOR PARENTS



#### Pros

- Convenience
- Compile a lot of information that parents can access
- Recruiting tool

#### Cons

- One-way communication
- Additional page to keep updated
- How do parents know it's there?

# INTERACTING WITH PARENTS: ATTENDING STUDENT ORIENTATION

#### Pros

- Two-way communication
- Fitting parents into an already scheduled meeting
- Parents can see how students/ faculty interact

#### Cons

- Can parents/students speak freely?
- Weekend/evening meeting
- May veer away from specific information for students to general information for parents
