### Certification Requirements for Employment Based Visas

(a) General. Under section 212(a)(5)(C) of the Act, an alien who seeks admission to the United States for the primary purpose of performing labor as a health care worker, other than a physician, is inadmissible unless he or she presents a certificate from the Commission on Graduates of Foreign Nursing Schools (CGFNS) or an equivalent credentialing organization. Section 212(r) of the Act provides an alternate certification process for nurses. The certification generally verifies that the alien's training, license, experience, and English-language ability meet minimum standards and are comparable with that required for an American health care worker of the same type.

### **Exemptions**

The following healthcare workers are exempt:

- Physicians
- · Researchers and teachers
- F/J and H-3 trainees
- Applicants for Adjustment of Status for family based or employment based outside of the listed healthcare occupations.
- Dependents of any non-immigrants or immigrants

### Affected Healthcare Occupations

- Licensed Practical or Vocational Nurses
- Registered Nurses
- Physical Therapists
- Occupational Therapists
- Physician Assistants
- Clinical Laboratory Technicians (Medical Technicians) Clinical Laboratory Scientists (Medical Laboratory Technologists)

  NOTE: Certification is required for alien graduates of American and
  Foreign programs.

# Authorized Credentialing Organizations.

- Commission on Graduates of Foreign Nursing (CGFNS) is authorized to issue health care worker certificates for all 7 occupations.
- The National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) is authorized to issue certificates for occupational therapists only.
- The Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy (FCCPT) is authorized to issue certificates for physical therapists only.
