International Scholar Update

H-1B petitions filed via standard processing are still lagging, normally taking approximately 4 months.

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) announced upcoming changes to its fee structure. **Effective November 23, 2010**, government filing fees will increase for most applications and petitions, although USCIS will reduce fees for a few individual applications and petitions. Any petition or application that USCIS receives on or after November 23, 2010 must include the new fee.

Below is a chart with changes to fees for USCIS services, which apply most commonly to international scholars.

I-539	Application to Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status	\$300	\$290
I-907	Premium Processing Service	\$1,000	\$1,225
