SoCal District Team Updates

Thank you to Mackenzie Bristol, formerly of ELS Language Centers - La Vern, for her service to the District as the Chair-Elect and congratulations on her new position at Emory University in Atlanta. Region VII's gain means the SoCal District is in search of a new Chair-Elect. If you are interested or know someone who would be a great candidate, watch for the Survey Monkey nomination ballot coming in early September. **Chair-Elect:** As part of the "Chair stream," the Chair-Elect is a one-year position, but the Chair-Elect is expected to then serve as Chair and then Past-Chair, for one year each.

As a Center Director of a private language school, she wants to spend these 12-weeks doing what her students do: study a language abroad in a full immersion environment. In analyzing student evaluations she has received from students this year, the top three student action drivers identified are the quality of the teachers, the amount learned, and staff helpfulness. Community College Updates

Governor Jerry Brown's 2014-15 State Budget Act:

A total of \$156.3 billion has been appropriated from the General Fund and other state funds. The budget makes substantial progress toward correcting fiscal problems, including \$5.1 billion to eliminate delayed payments to school and community college districts. Community colleges will receive almost \$400 million in new funding, including \$140 million to increase attendance by 2.75% and \$170 million for counseling and other student support services.

City College of San Francisco Given More Time To Meet Accreditation:

Ed Lee, the mayor of San Francisco and <u>Brice W. Harris</u>, the Chancellor of the California Community College system asked to give City College of San Francisco more time to meet accreditation requirements. They wrote in the <u>article</u>, Give City College more time to meet accreditation requirements: "We stand with the students at City College of San Francisco. Our offices have worked together since July of last year when the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges threatened its loss of accreditation."

Senator Paul Simon Award Applications For 2015 Now Available:

Two community colleges, Green River Community College and Lone Star College System have received NAFSA's 2014 <u>Senator Paul Simon Award for Campus Internationalization</u>. This achievement demonstrates that community colleges are making considerable progress in their international efforts and are providing exemplary strategies in their approach to internationalization.

The Senator Paul Simon Award for Campus Internationalization recognizes colleges and universities that are making significant, well-planned, well-executed, and well-documented progress toward comprehensive internationalization—especially those using innovative and creative approaches.

The Simon Award for Comprehensive Internationalization is granted to a limited number of institutions each year—usually no more than five.
