The ICT Network leader will chair the SC. The SC will consist of 3 to 5 members, who should be familiar with intercultural communication and training theory and practice. Members will ideally have at least one year professional experience in the field. Skill in concise writing, as well as an interest in mentoring others and participating in online discussions will be helpful. Two-year commitment, renewable once. 5 to 10 hours per month, depending on the volume of activity on the network. Participation in conference calls (min. 4 per year) and email communication with the TLS KC leadership team and staff.
