Dear Chairman Diaz-Balart and Ranking Member Lee:

We write in support of the Increase and Diversify Education Abroad for U.S. Students (IDEAS) program, a Department of State (State) initiative that promotes study abroad educational opportunities, in the Fiscal Year 2024 House State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations bill. As our world becomes increasingly interconnected, it is crucial that students are given the opportunity to expand their world knowledge through study abroad.

Currently, only ten percent of American college students participate in study abroad prior to graduation. Minority, first-generation, and community school students are underrepresented among participants. Furthermore, study aboard programs rarely prioritize studying in developing countries that would offer students new, enlightening experiences. Expanding opportunities would benefit both students and our nation as a whole.

State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs provides competitive grants to U.S. universities and colleges to establish, expand, and diversify their study abroad programming through the IDEAS grant program. To build on the success of the IDEAS grant program, we humbly request the inclusion of the following report language:

Of the funds provided under this Act to the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, not less than \$5 million shall be set aside for grants under the Increase and Diversify Education Abroad for U.S. Students (IDEAS) grant program. The Subcommittee also urges State to rename the IDEAS program the "Senator Paul Simon Study Abroad Program."
