THESE MEETINGS OFFER A CONCENTRATED OPPORTUNITY FOR THE EXCHANGE OF IDEAS AND OFFER A NETWORK FOR SHARING INFORMATION AS IT SEEKS TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF AND SUPPORT FOR INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION.
