- Cancellation or modification requests for registration and workshops must be made in writing and received no later than Friday, May 24, 2024, and no later than Tuesday, May 7, 2024, for the Management Development Program. Any cancellations received after these dates will not be refunded.
- Refunds, if approved, will be processed four to six weeks after the conference.
