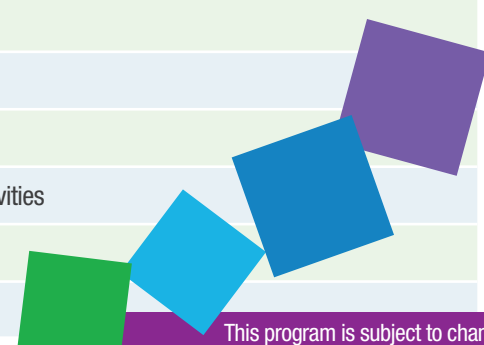

CAPTCHA coinventor,
entrepreneur, and
educator

A noted and influential information technology leader and speaker, Luis von Ahn is an entrepreneur and consulting professor at Carnegie Mellon University and is considered one of the pioneers of crowdsourcing.

Currently serving as the CEO and cofounder of Duolingo, von Ahn is best known for co-inventing CAPTCHAs, which distinguish between humans and bots online; receiving a MacArthur Fellowship; and being named one of the “10 Most Brilliant Scientists” by *Popular Science* magazine. In 2023, he was inducted into the National Inventors’ Hall of Fame.

Social justice advocates and
cofounders of the Plessy &
Ferguson Initiative

Phoebe Ferguson and Keith Plessy are direct descendants of the opposing parties in the 1896 Plessy v. Ferguson U.S. Supreme Court case, which upheld the constitutionality of Jim Crow laws mandating segregation under the “separate but equal” doctrine. In 2009, they cofounded the Plessy & Ferguson Initiative to advance civil rights, history, memorialization, and transitional justice.

Both native New Orleanians, each are committed civil activists and champions of equitable education access for all. Together, they visit academic and historical institutions, spreading their message that mutual history can be a tool to create unity and understanding.

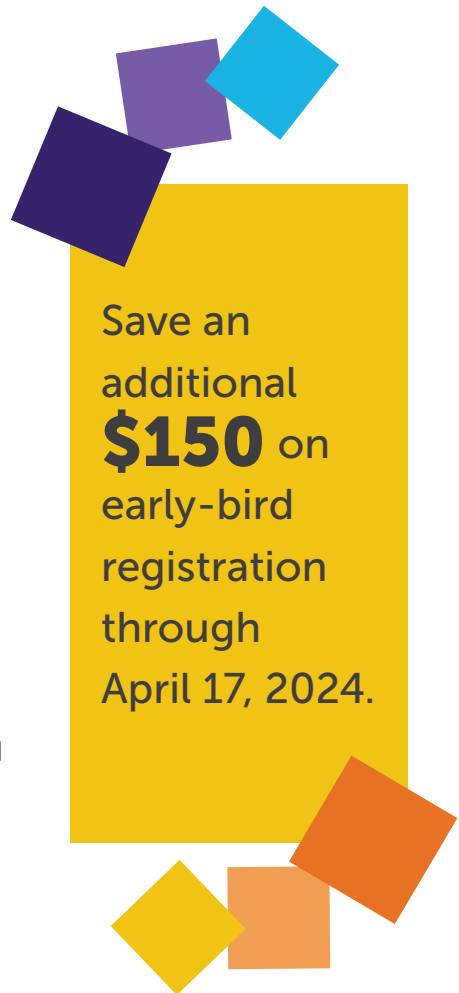
