Policy Updates - COVID-19

USCIS

- Announces 60-Day Grace Period to Respond to RFEs, NOIDS or to file I-290B (May 1, 2020)
- Extends Suspension of In-Person Services at Local USCIS Field Offices (April 24, 2020)
- Announces Data Entry Delay for Cap-Subject H-1B Petitions Until at least May 1,
 2020
- Announces flexibility in submitting required signatures (March 20, 2020)

Travel related (CBP/DOS)

- Coronavirus Proclamation of April 22, 2020 Limits Entry of Certain Immigrants (April 22, 2020)
- DHS and CDC Extend Canada-Mexico Restrictions for 30 Additional Days (April 20, 2020), continued restrictions for entry to the US from Schengen area, UK, and China
- General suspension of visa services announcement from <u>travel.state.gov</u>
