"As the largest and most comprehensive association dedicated to international education, we believe it is our responsibility to create and celebrate efforts that develop international education practitioners from all backgrounds." The goals of the fellowship are a) provide representation of international education professionals from underrepresented minority backgrounds; b) ensure the inclusion of participants into established professionally recognized NAFSA programming and networks; c) support the continued learning and sustained engagement of participants as they establish themselves in their professional journey and d) lead the empowerment of participants with resources and tools to help them give back to their institutions and communities, and the field at large.
